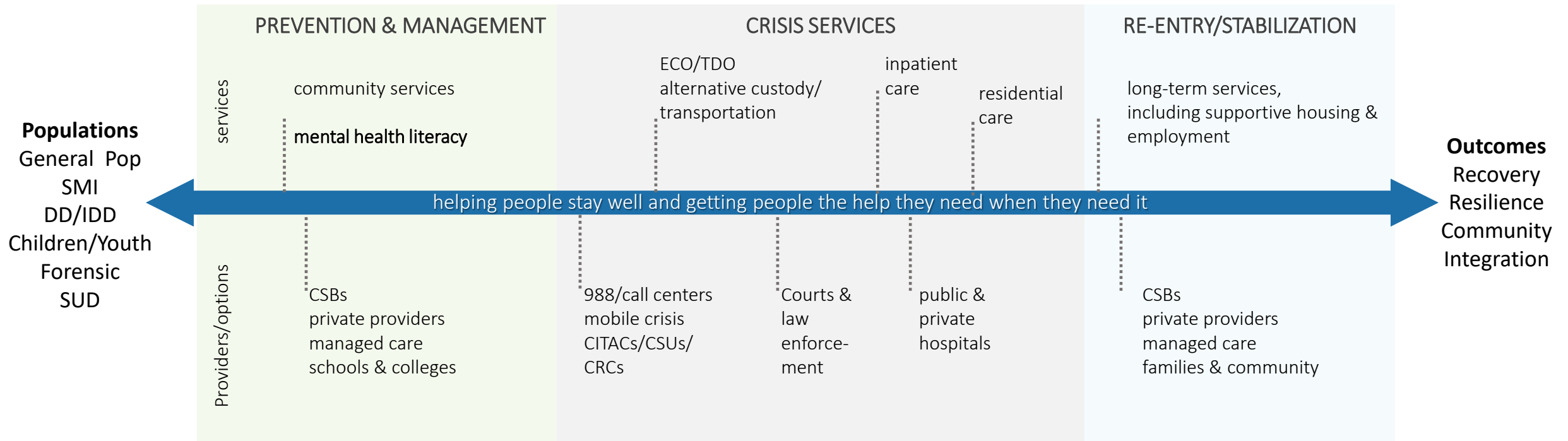


Behavioral Health System Redesign

Constructing a clear, quality path for Virginians with behavioral health disorders and developmental disabilities

Virginia's system must respond to people's unique and dynamic journeys to recovery and wellness. Prevention services help people manage their own symptoms and stay well. Crisis services respond when people need emergency assistance. Inpatient care should only occur in the most severe cases, and may be needed for longer-term stabilization or restoration beyond crisis services. Re-entry services help people with basic services needed for success like employment and housing.
